New Wash House	As the Camp expands, we need more washroom capacity, especially for staff. We are currently developing plans for a modular structure that could also host some overflow staff accomodation.	One a concept is finalized and costed, will likely need further support	\$150,000.00

Signage	We have undertaken the initial internal signs for the Dining Hall, and cabin names. We would like to replace program area signs, road signs and site signage with new.	Cash to support implementation	\$2,500.00
